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Theme Descriptions

Bright Bold Artists

K-3 Grade (M-F) 6/28

They are BRIGHT, they are BOLD & they are definitely ARTISTIC! Join us as we explore artists of the past, as well as current artists, that are known for their use of bright bold colors. We will experiment & create with our colors all week. Some projects will include Bold Dot Wall Hangings, Drippy Graffiti Hearts & Crazy Face Food Heads.

Recycled & Recreated

K-6 Grade (M-F) 7/19

It's a WIN-WIN of a week! Good for the earth & good for your creative soul! Come make art with items that are not traditionally thought of as art media or tools. Find out how cool an old plastic utensil or bottle cap can be for printing. Reclaim cardboard and other crazy scrap items to create a colorful patchwork house collage. Everything this week has a second chance. We'll stay busy with Colorful Plastic Lanterns, Recycled Robots, Dripped Painted Newspaper and a Tie-dye Flower Collage.

Faces & Places

2-7 Grade (M-F) 7/5

What's in a work of art? Usually a FACE or a PLACE. This week we will focus on a variety of portrait styles from realistic to totally crazy. We will experiment with common places in art like landscapes, seascapes & cityscapes. We will also surprise you with some not so common places! Nature Faces, 3D Swing Art & Silly Surreal Collages & much more.

Farm to Table

K-3 Grade (M-F) 7/26

Farm to ART TABLE that is! This week is all about bringing the amazing attributes of farm-life to life through the arts & our creations. We will check out all the ways farmers enrich our lives and we will capture these moments and items in our artwork. Project will include Vegetable Garden Collages, Beehive Print-Making, Sunflower Art. We'll also make lots of furry, fuzzy & muddy barnyard friends.

Fiesta Fun

K-6 Grade (M-F) 8/9

We are ending the summer program with a pARTy themed week. A celebration of the time spent creating together! Join us the last week to explore art of the Spanish culture. So many bright colors, rich traditions, festive holidays and amazing artists. We will create art influenced by this amazing culture. We'll stay busy making Painted Weaving Hangings, Fancy Fridas, & Neon Folk Art.

Asymmetrical Journey

6-12 Grade (M-F) 7/12

Nothing this past year has been "normal"...so why should this week of camp be anything but asymmetrical and a little out of whack! We will explore mixed media with some of our favorite media & techniques to create one-of-kind pieces that depict how we felt about this past year...the good & the bad. 2021 General Policies, Information & Procedures

Here's to another great summer of creativity, learning and fun at A&S Studio. Please review summer policies and procedures to help the studio run smoothly & safely. Thank you in advance. 😊

General Information:

You may register your child(ren) for as many weeks as you wish. You have the option of attending full-day or half-day workshops based on your wants and needs. Half-day artists may choose from AM or PM workshop sessions. All sessions are filled on a first come, first serve basis. (NOTE: Middle/High school week is only full-day 10-3pm)

- Full-days are from 9am-3:30pm (lunch time included).
- Half-day AM sessions will begin at 9am and end at 12:00pm.
- Half-day PM sessions will begin at 12:30 and end at 3:30pm.
- All half-day artists have the option to add the extra ½ hour of lunchtime (12-12:30).

Projects are open-ended and your artist will be challenged independently and able to work to his or her highest level always. Project extensions and adaptations are always offered to accommodate all artists and ability levels. We will be setting up studio buddies this year to support young artists and promote self-esteem in older artists.

Please make sure your emergency contact/cell phone #s and allergy info are always up to date. Notify us if anything changes. If someone different is picking your child up, please notify the instructor at drop off.

The regular studio phone will not be answered during workshop hours (9-3:30) to prevent lesson interruptions. Art Instructors will always have their cell phones on them. We will be giving out an emergency line/number to text or call during camp hours if your child is in class or you need us during instruction hours. All other non-emergency phone calls will be returned at the end of each camp day.

Art & Soul sessions are “drop off” due to limited studio space and mainly distractions. There are lots of walking trails in the Villages of Urbana, 2 Urbana Parks, Restaurants, Starbucks & Urbana Library within 2 miles. Also, we are 10 minutes from Target/Bed Bath & Beyond/Home Depot and more. **Due to Covid procedures, we are not allowing parents to come in the studio at drop off or pick up.** We will post lots of photos and send all the art home to share with you.

Cell phones are permitted in studio. Art & Soul is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damage to cell phones. Please **do not** allow your child to bring **any** personal art materials or toys to class.

Lunch/Snack

Art & Soul is a **NUT FREE** facility due to numerous allergies. Please take the time to check your child's lunch and snack to make sure it does not contain any nut allergens.

There will be a supervised lunchtime from 12:00-12:30 included for full-day artists. Please pack a bagged lunch.

Half-day artists have the option to add ½ hour lunchtime for the week (\$20) or “drop in” on select days (\$5/day). You may add this time, at anytime, during the week.

All artists (half-day & full-day) are to pack a healthy snack each day for break-time (10:30am & 2pm). Artists are welcomed to keep water bottles on tables. There is a water fountain in the studio for refills.

Attire

Dress comfortably in “play clothes”. While most materials we use are labeled “washable”, we do sometimes get a little colorful. 😊

PLEASE NO FLIP FLOPS. We will be taking advantage of the backyard area of the studio. Sandals are acceptable, as long as they have back straps and your child can run safely for outdoor games. Sneakers may be kept in your child’s cubby for the week to change into.

Illnesses/Absences

Please be courteous, and do not bring your child to the studio if he or she is running a fever, has thrown up due to illness, or has any contagious illness. Please do not bring your artist if he or she has had an exposure to someone with covid.

Art days/hours missed due to illness, doctor appointments, other activities or last-minute family plans **will not** be reimbursed and **no make-up days** will be offered.

Registration & Payment

Registration Forms must include a signed studio release waiver, initialed Covid Waiver and a 20% (non-refundable) deposit in order to hold your spot. The 20% deposit will be put toward your tuition total. You may also choose to pay your camp in full.

Art & Soul accepts: Cash, Check, VISA, MasterCard, Discover and PayPal. Preferred Method: Check/Cash. Checks made payable to: Urbana Art & Soul.

The balance of your camp tuition (if you pay 20% deposit) will be due on or before May 21st. **A \$25 late fee will be charged for balances paid after Friday, May 21st.**

All registrations after May 21st are to be **paid in full**. No partial payments/deposits.

Multiple Week Discount: If your artist signs up for more than one week of summer art you will receive a discount on his/her second and each additional week.

Family Discount: Save 10% on your **2nd** and **each additional** child. Can be combined with multiple week discount as well. (1st child is full-price.) Family discount applies to siblings only.

Refunds:

Tuition that is paid in full may be refunded (minus 20%) if requested **before May 21st**. The 20% deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. **No refunds or make-up days** will be given for days that are missed. No refunds after June 1st. Registrations after May 21st are non-refundable. You may find another artist to take/transfer your reserved seat.
